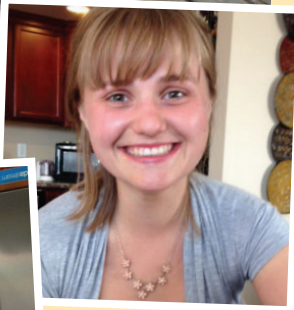

SUPPORTED LIVING SERVICES



Overview

Pathway's Supported Living Services offer adults with disabilities the opportunity to make choices. Residents receive as much support as needed to live, work and play in their

community. Individualized services include, but are not limited to: cooking, shopping, cleaning, personal care, transportation for appointments, visiting friends, and participating in community activities. Customized supports ensure each resident has opportunities to thrive in the environment of their choice.



Supports and Services

Residents may receive a variety of support services from our talented Supported Living Coaches including, but not limited to the following:

- Managing medication and overall health and safety
- Managing finances
- Cooking, cleaning and personal care
- Transportation to and from appointments
- Using adaptive devices or augmented communication
- Coordinating other services such as education, food stamps, mental health, etc.
- Help developing friendships and personal connections
- Coordinating community activities
- Facilitating and implementing a Person Centered Plan
- Coordinating employment support and services

24 hours/day, 7 days/week**
